Zoe: Hey, Takuya. What's going on?

Takuya: Oh, hi Zoe! I was just checking on the **overnight bus**⁵ schedule.

Z: Oh, are you going on a trip?

T: Yeah, I'm traveling to Tokyo this weekend.

Z: Uh-huh. What are you going to do in Tokyo?

T: Actually, I have a few things planned. First, I'm going to a handshake event on Friday in Akihabara.

Z: A handshake event? What's that?

T: It's an event where you get to shake hands and talk to Japanese idols.

Z: Oh, like pop stars? That's cool. Who are you going to shake hands with?

T: My favorite idol group, The Shibuya Sisters!

Z: The Shibuya Sisters! Oh, yeah, I like them. I love their song, "Shibuya Shake Down".

T: That's my favorite, too.

Z: What **else**⁶ are you going to do?

T: Well, on Saturday, I'm going to a *manga* and *cosplay* convention at Tokyo Big Site.

Z: Tokyo Big Site?

T: It's a **huge**⁷ convention hall.

Z: I see. So, are you into *cosplay*? Are you going to **dress up**⁸?

T: I love *manga*, but I'm not so into *cosplay*. I'll take a lot of pictures, though. It's really fun. Some of the people have **awesome**⁹ costumes.

Z: That sounds like an amazing weekend!

T: That's not all. There's a gaming convention as well. I'll go to that on Sunday.

Z: **Are you kidding me?**¹⁰ First, you're going to meet and shake hands with your favorite pop stars, then you're going to a *manga* and *cosplay* event, and then you're going to a gaming convention! How is that possible?

Z: (ha ha) Super *otaku*? What do you mean?
